- Post graduate programme (M.Com./MBA) - Graduate from a recognized university or a pass in the Final of ICAI. / A successful completion of BBA/B.Com., through ICAI offered by Bharathiar University.

After checking the original certificates, the enrollment letter conforming the admission along with the original certificates will be sent to the successful candidates.
